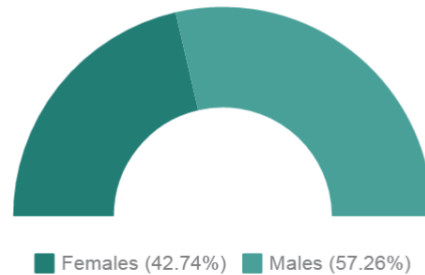
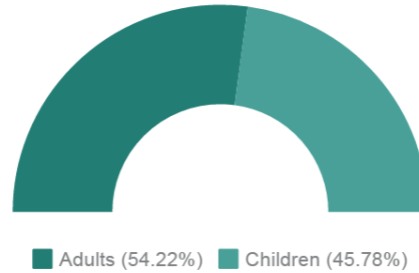


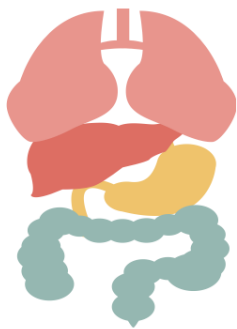
1. Irish CF population

35-40 people are diagnosed each year

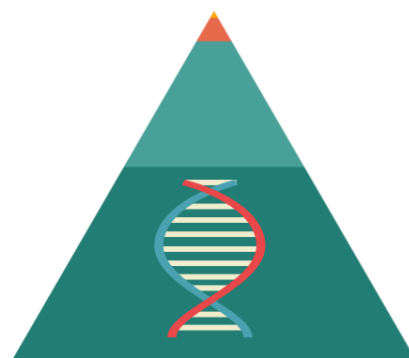
Newborn screening began in July 2011

3. CF genotypes

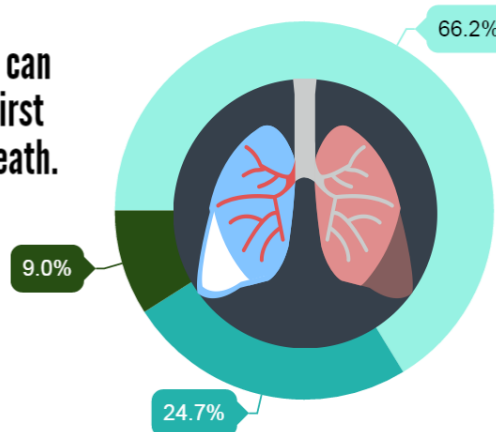
**F508del is the most common

4. Lung health

FEV1 is the amount of air that can be forcefully exhaled in the first second after taking a deep breath.



FEV1% is a percentage of the average value for healthy people of the same age, gender and height, which is set at 100%.

■ Mild to normal (>69% FEV1) (66.27%) ■ Moderate (40-69% FEV1) (24.72%) ■ Severe (<40% FEV1) (9.01%)
