532 children under 18 years

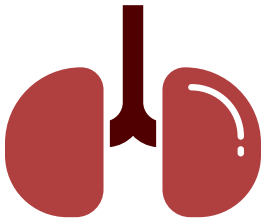


## Adults

## Average lung function in the CF population



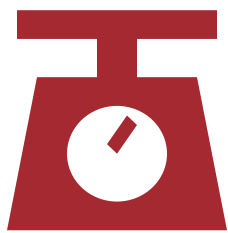
Male adult 68.6%

Female adult 70.6%

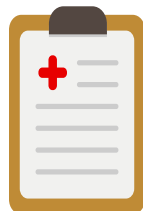

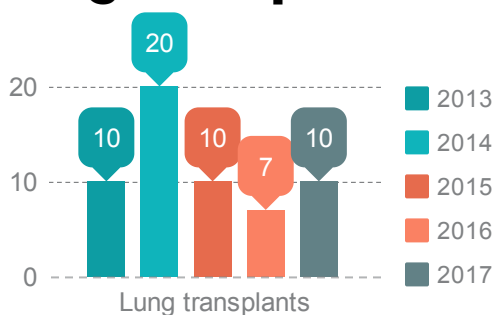
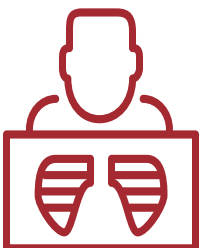
